Cost: \$60 reserves your seat, cash or check payable to Grace Presbyterian Church

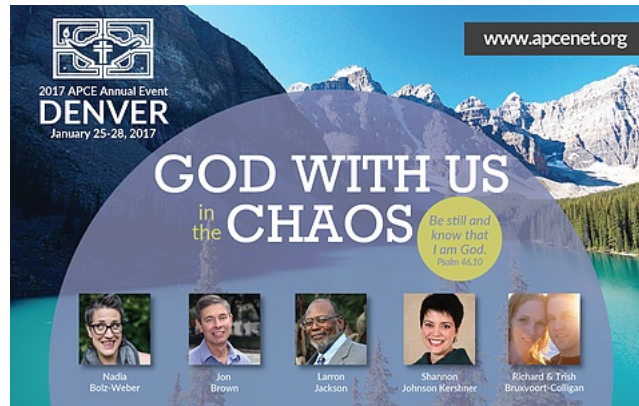
