WELLS OF REVIVAL PRAYER GATHERING AT PRINCETON CEMETERY

On Saturday, August 12, there will be a *Wells of Revival* Prayer Gathering at the Princeton Cemetery at 12:00 noon-2:00PM. In the Nineteenth Century a local historian called this site "The Westminster Abbey of the US" (John Hageman, 1878). Please join us at:

From downtown Princeton take Nassau Street to Witherspoon Street and turn north for 2 blocks. The Cemetery will be on your right.

The Cemetery includes graves for 1 US President (Grover Cleveland), 1 Vice President (Aaron Burr, Jr.), and most of the past Presidents of Princeton. Notables include Jonathan and Sarah Edwards, Aaron Burr (Sr. and Jr.), John Witherspoon, and many others. You can see a detailed summary at https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Princeton_Cemetery.

During our prayer time we will look at Princeton's role during the Great Awakening (Jonathan Edwards and Aaron Burr, Sr.), the Revolution (John Witherspoon), and three Princeton Theologians that trained generations of pastors during the 19th and 20th Centuries (Archibald Alexander, Charles Hodge, and B.B.
