Join Eastern Service Workers Association's membership of low-income service, temporary and domestic workers as we redouble our efforts this winter to help each other survive while we fight for government policies that prioritize the needs of the majority of us.

We need living wage jobs and affordable utility service — including heating, hot water and electricity! Rather than taking decisive action to address these needs, the State of New Jersey is giving away over \$1 billion of our tax money as gifts—tax breaks—to corporate utility monopolies and financial giants; according to the NJ State Constitution, "to promote the welfare of the people..." these taxpayer revenues should fund living-wage jobs, primary and higher

education and public health. We need independent organization to fight for policy changes that solve problems for working people and our economy.

Since 1976, Eastern Service Workers Association (ESWA), a free and voluntary private membership association, has organized its annual Winter Survival Campaign to aid members during the season when unemployment reaches as high as 25% for many low-income workers. Members organize supplemental food, blanket and winter clothing distributions, a heater loan program, utility and water advocacy and more, in addition to the year-round self-help Benefit Program. These benefits alone provide no solution, but enable members the stability to organize campaigns demanding resources such as home heating as a right.

History has taught us that the only way changes to benefit the entire community have ever come about is through the lowest-paid of our community organizing together, independent of government funding, alongside concerned students, professionals, business owners, retirees and more.
